Dennis presented a graph of charts showing the budget, excluding Gold Sale. Discussion and questions were presented to Dennis on how to keep the congregation informed on the state of the churches finances.

#### Membership and Evangelism May 9, 2018

Tina reported that they are looking at creating a fostering program, Fellowship Friends, for new members to assist them in getting involved.


